

## Statement for Sellers

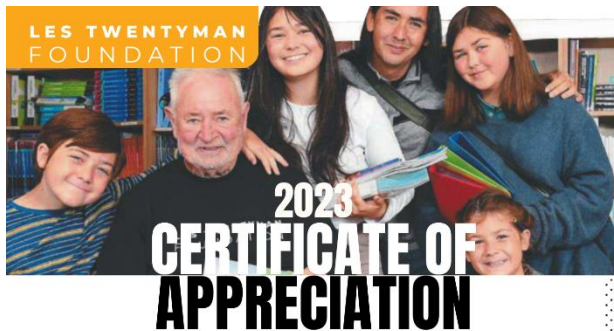
### Closure was to be in December but now deferred until at least March.
